

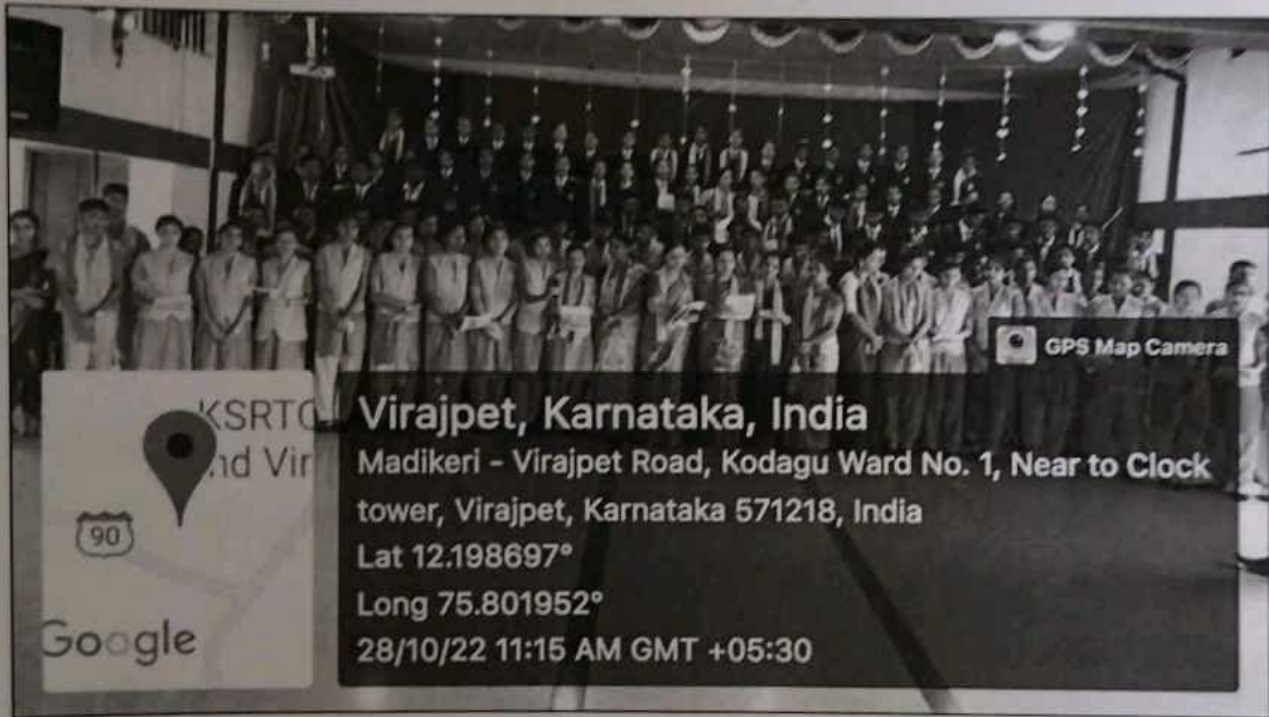

## Report on Christmas Celebration

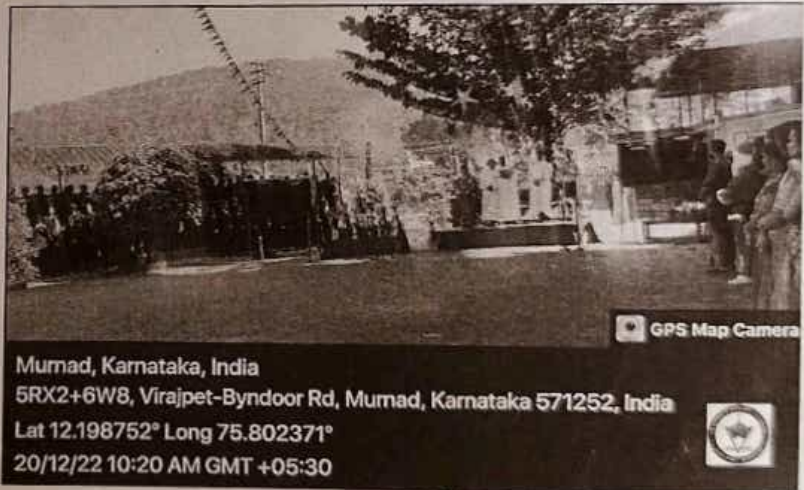


**Venue:** College Campus

**Thadiyandamol"**

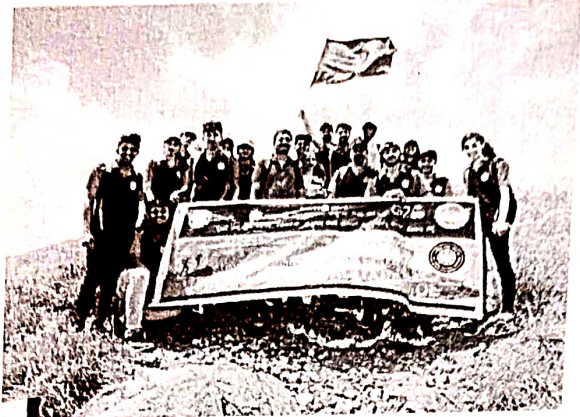
**Event Name:-** Trekking in Thadiyandamol Mountain.

The NSS Unit of St. Anne's Degree College and Kodagu District Forest Department jointly organized

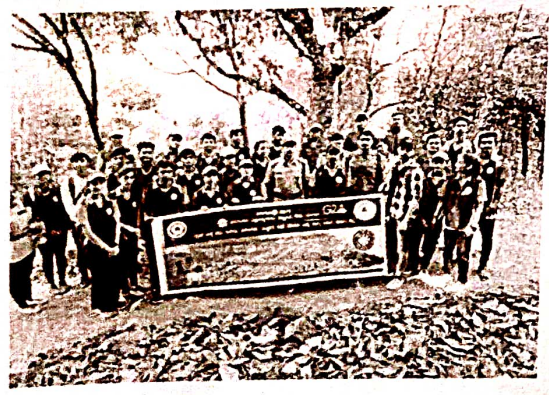

the St. Anne's Degree College took initiation of this event.

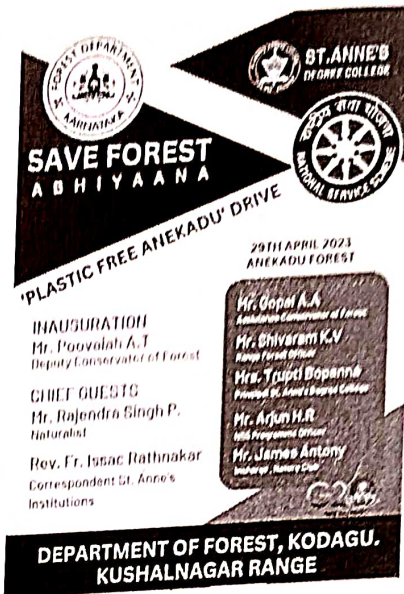

**Introduction:**

The Plastic Free Drive Program is an initiative undertaken by the National Service Scheme (NSS) in collaboration with the Kodagu Forest Department in the Anekaadu Forest Zone nearby Kushalnagar. The program aims to raise awareness about the detrimental effects of plastic pollution on the environment and promote sustainable practices among the local communities residing in and around forest areas.



**Objectives:**

- a) To educate local communities about the harmful impacts of plastic pollution on forests, wildlife, and ecosystems.
- b) To encourage the adoption of eco-friendly alternatives to single-use plastics.
- c) To organize clean-up drives to remove plastic waste from forest areas.
- d) To promote recycling and waste management practices within the community.

The NSS volunteers, in collaboration with the Kodagu Forest Department, conduct awareness campaigns and Plastic Free Zone Drive in Anekaadu Forest Area kodagu. In this campaigns NSS volunteers, along with forest department officials, cleaned-up drives in Anekaadu forest areas. These drives aim to remove plastic waste and other litter from the forest surroundings, ensuring a cleaner and healthier environment for both wildlife and humans. The NSS volunteers collected more than four tractors of plastic waste in Highway Road side of Anekaadu Forest Zone.

among local communities about the harmful effects of plastic pollution. The number of individuals using eco-friendly alternatives has significantly increased, reducing the consumption of single-use plastics.



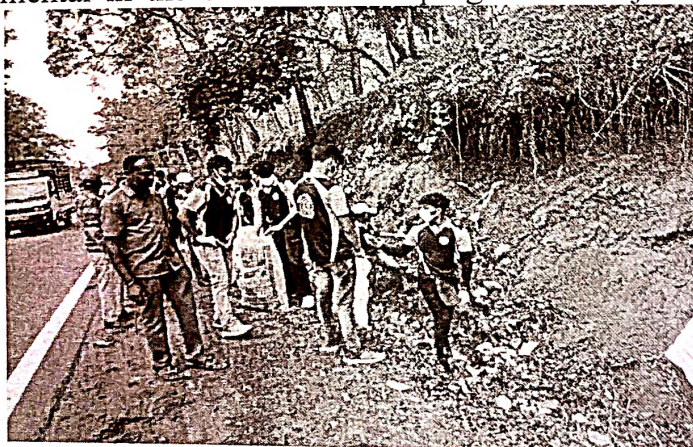

towards the environment. Active participation in clean-up drives and the adoption of sustainable practices have strengthened community engagement.

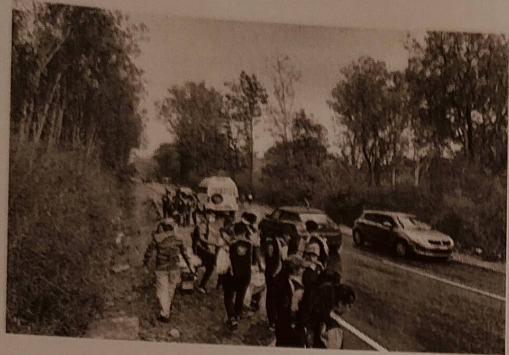

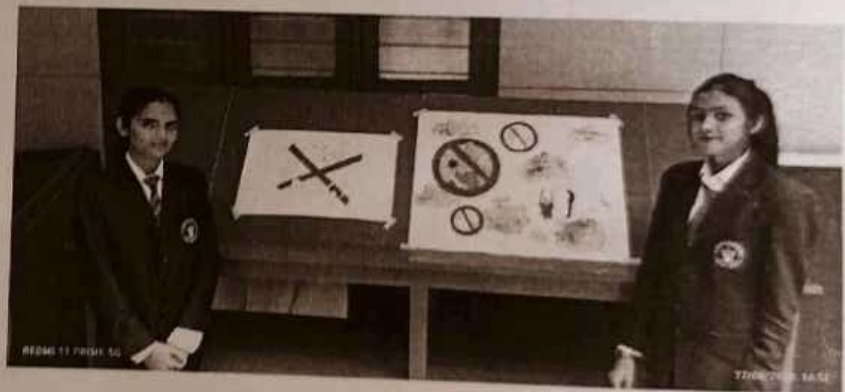

A total of 15 students took part in the poster-making event. The resulting posters were displayed on the notice board of the cultural club, located in the quadrangle.

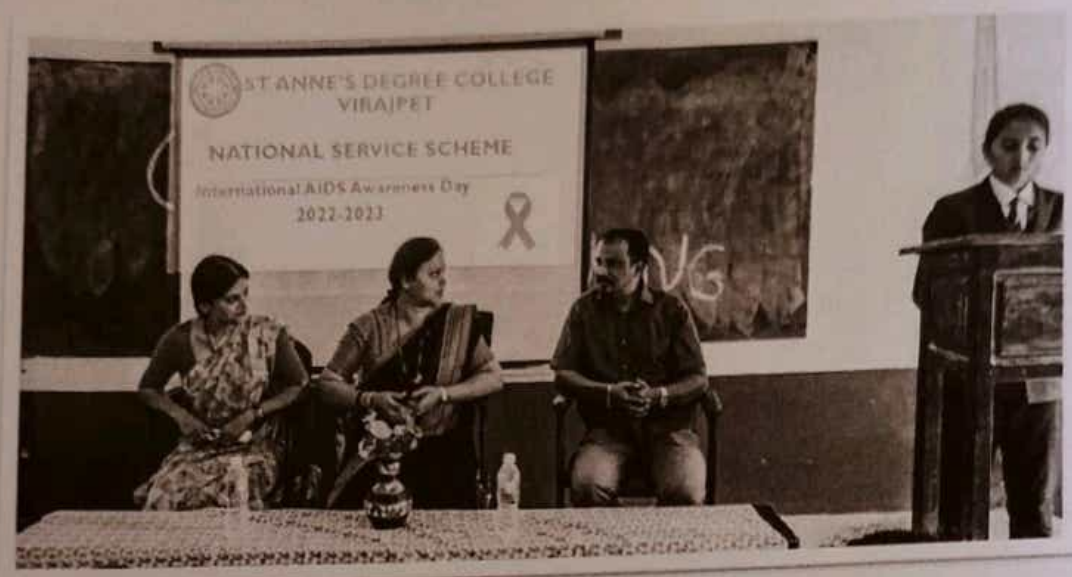
