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
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LITERARY CLUB

Students were actively participated and eager to grasp the branch of linguistic of words and treats the history of words and their components, with the aim of determining their origin and derivation.





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
ST ANNE'S DEGREE COLLEGE, VIRAJPET DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH INNOVATION AND LIFE


