A Short History Of St. Anne's.

St: 'Anne's church Virajpet was established in the year 1792. The present St. Anne's educational institution has a long history of more than 175 years. Even though the church was started in 1792, till 1842 there was no school attached to the church. In 1842 the French missionary father J M Newness who believed that the integral development could be achieved through the medium of education, started the lower primary school. The medium of instruction was in English. In 1962 all the independent schools run by the churches in Coorg came under one administration of Mysore diocese, under the registered society of "MYSORE DIOCESEAN EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY (M.D.E.S)". The degree college was started in honour of St. Anne, mother of Blessed Virgin Mary in the year 2007. College had a humble beginning with bachelor's degree in community of ischolars to advance knowledge, face social challenges and pursue intellectual and personal fulfilment.
