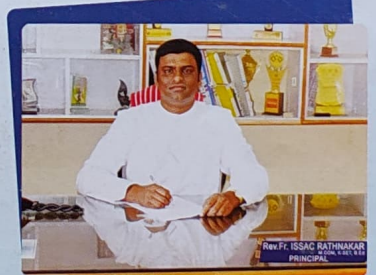
225th YEAR Jubilee
