Overall the competition proved informative and inspiring to the students. It also provided a platform to all the students of BCA to exhibit their knowledge and talent.

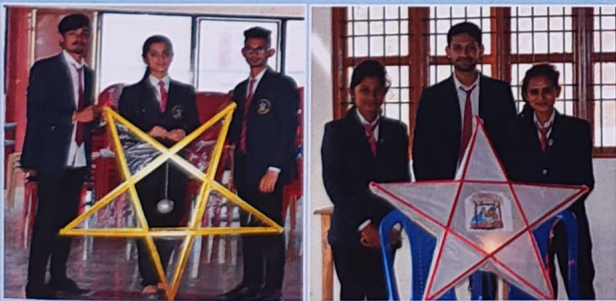


STAR - MAKING COMPETITION
