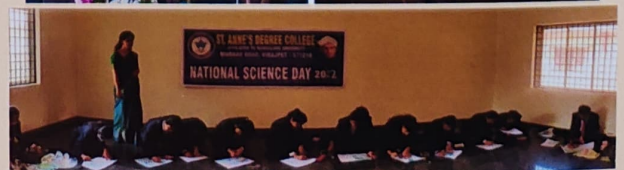
**NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY

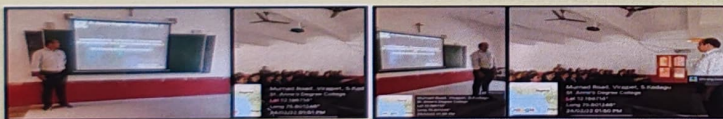


## BLOCKCHAIN TECHNOLOGY

AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV**

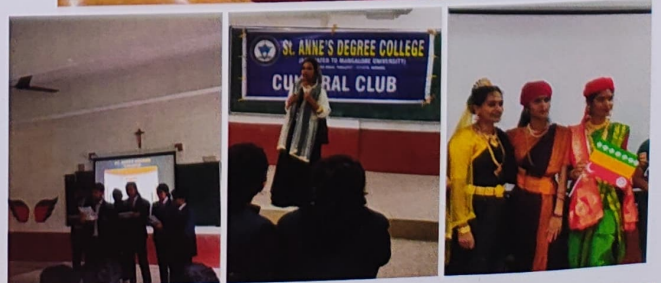
In connection with Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, the 75th Independence Day celebration various programmes were organised for the students.
