Fr Issac Rathankar articulated that the Intellectual Property Rights promote the dissemination of knowledge by allowing creators, to license their intellectual property to others, thereby facilitating collaboration and exchange of ideas. Mrs. Trupti Bopanna, Principal, St. Anne's Degree College addressed about "WIPO" theme of the year 2023, "Women and IP". The Keynote speaker of the event Mr. Amrit Sommaiah, Assistant Public Prosecutor, Madikeri conveyed the basic knowledge of intellectual property and its impact on human creativity and legal protection.

In session 1, the guest speaker, C.A Anwesh Shetty explained about several types of IPR such as copyright, patent, trademark and geographical indications. The session concluded by summarizing about the registration aspects and exploit ideas into implementation.

In session 2, the guest speaker Mr. Madappa B.B, Advocate, Virajpet gave an overview on Intellectual Property Rights and its laws. He described that WIPO and WTO are the main organization that regulates the IPR. He defined IP as executively created for a person which nobody can copy it and specified that only when intellectual property is registered it can become an Intellectual Property Rights.

Both the sessions concluded with a productive question and answer session, helping students to understand intellectual property rights in an effective and efficient manner.

The speaker Advocate Mrs. Thara Subbaiah explained about the Human rights and women harassment. she also explained about the importance empowerment of women with various illustrations.

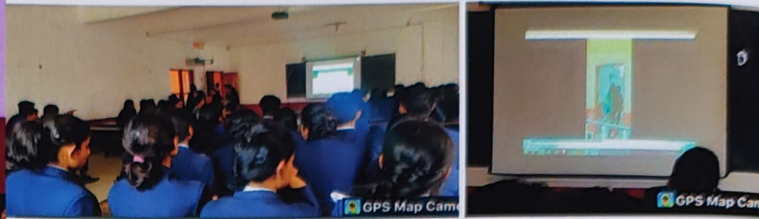
The session was organized by Mrs. Leena N.R the convener of Human rights cell.

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS

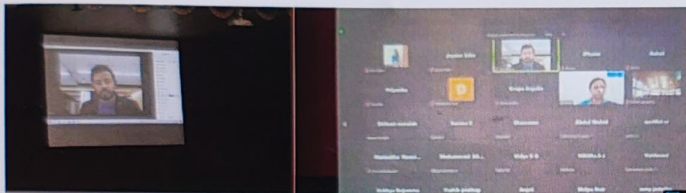
